

ORDINANCE NO. 2 – 2019
CITY OF EGG HARBOR CITY

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 259 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY
OF EGG HARBOR CITY TO RESTRICT ACCESS ON CERTAIN ROADS WITHIN THE
CITY OF EGG HARBOR

WHEREAS, the City of Egg Harbor City finds that in order to promote the safety of the public, particularly in the areas around the public schools; and,

WHEREAS, limiting the direction and access to vehicular traffic in certain areas will better promote and protect public safety; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed issues related to traffic flow and safety and has recommended the implementation of certain Amendments to the Municipal Code in order to promote said safety; NOW THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Egg Harbor City, County of Atlantic, and State of New Jersey as follows:

A. Chapter 259-7 is hereby amended to designate the following parts of streets as one-way streets in the direction indicated:

Diesterweg Avenue Direction: _____ from 7th Terrace to Cincinnati Avenue

7th Terrace Direction: _____ from Durer Street to Buffalo Avenue

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED,

Chapter 259 of the Code of the City of Egg Harbor City is hereby amended to include the following additional Subsection:

§ 259-17 Vehicular traffic prohibited.

No vehicles other than emergency vehicles shall be permitted to drive on Diesterweg Avenue between 7th Terrace to Cincinnati Avenue

B. To the extent the streets covered by this ordinance are covered by other ordinances establishing restrictions, those ordinances are hereby amended to exclude these streets from those restrictions.

C. If any part of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the intent that the balance and remainder of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

D. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law and after appropriate signage has been installed advising the public of the new restrictions.
