The Village of Ellenville hereby authorizes the disbursement of certain funds to the General Fund from the "Special Reserve Fund", created by adoption of the NYS Legislature in 1997, which is held and maintained by M&T Bank within the Village, for the purpose of eliminating/decreasing the projected budgeted shortfall for the 2024 Fiscal Year.

The amount which is authorized and to be disbursed to the General Fund is Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000.00) Dollars. This local law is made in conformance with the conditions and objectives of the Special Reserve Fund.

The adoption of this Local Law is subject to passage by (1) a roll call vote of the Board of Trustees and (2) a mandatory referendum referendum which shall be conducted in conformance with Article 9 of the NYS Village Law. Until both occur and are duly passed in conformance with Article 9, this local law shall not go into effect.

If any of the provisions of this local law are in violation with or are preempted by any other State or Federal Law and are rendered unenforceable, this provision shall be severed from the remainder of the Village Code and the remained shall be valid and enforceable.


