ORDINANCE NO.947

AN ORDINANCE OF ELIZABETH TOWNSHIP, ALLEGHENY COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 845 AND ESTABLISHING THE
ENTIRE LENGTH OF WILDCAT HOLLOW WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP AS A ONE
WAY STREET.

Whereas, the Commissioners of Elizabeth Township have determined that it is in
the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of its residents to establish Wildcat
Hollow as a one way street.

Now, therefore, be it ordained and enacted by the authority of the Commissioners
of Elizabeth Township as follows:

Section One: It is hereby established that the entire length of Wildcat Hollow is a one
way street in the Southwest direction of travel.

Section Two: Any ordinance or part thereof in conflict herewith is hereby repealed to
the extent of said conflict.
