

ORDINANCE NO. **364**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELIZABETHVILLE, COUNTY OF DAUPHIN, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 13-101 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELIZABETHVILLE, LICENSING OF TRANSIENT RETAIL BUSINESSES**

Section 13-101. Definitions, *Licensing of Transient Retail Businesses*, is hereby amended to define Transient Retail Business as follows:

- A. Engaging in peddling, soliciting, or taking orders, either by sample or otherwise, for any goods, wares, or merchandise upon any street, alley, sidewalk, or public ground, or from house to house, within the Borough; or,
- B. Selling, soliciting, or taking orders for any goods, wares, or merchandise, from a fixed location upon any street, alley, sidewalk, or public ground within the Borough, on a temporary basis, which shall include, but not be limited to, such activities conducted at the time of special occasions or celebrations, for seasonal purposes, or for yearly holidays.


All other provisions of the said Part 1 remain in effect as stated.
