I. INTENT

Section 110-6 of the Village Code specifies the amount of fees and costs which shall be paid in connection with the issuance of permits allowing filming within the Village. This provision was initially enacted more than twenty years ago. By reason of the Village's experience with such permits during that period, as well as the increase in various costs during that period, plus the change to the physical and demographic conditions of the Village during that period, the Village Board of Trustees has determined that it will serve the health, welfare and benefit of the Village to amend that fee and cost structure to more realistically reflect the actual burdens to the Village, its residents and its businesses resulting from filming activities in the Village for which a permit is issued.

II. AMENDMENT

Section 110-6 of the Village Code is hereby repealed, and a new Section 110-6 is hereby adopted, which shall state as follows:

"Section 110-6. Fees.

- A. The base fee for a filming permit shall be \$1500 for each and every day or part thereof for which the permit is issued.
- B. In addition to the base fee, the applicant for a permit shall pay for the actual costs to be incurred by the Village by reason of the filming activities. Such costs shall include but not be limited to: the use of Village personnel for traffic control, parking direction and similar activities; the loss of parking revenues; insurance and legal costs; administrative expenses; and the use of any other Village personnel, services or equipment in connection with the filming activity. Prior to the issuance of the permit, the applicant shall pay such costs on an estimated basis and shall also post adequate security to ensure the payment of any such costs which cannot be reliably estimated.
- C. In addition to the base fee and actual costs required by subsections A and B above, the applicant shall also pay a fee to compensate the Village and its residents for the interference with and diminution in the quality of life caused by the filming activities resulting from factors such as the loss of parking availability; increased noise; excessive pedestrian crowding; reduced accessibility to certain businesses and areas of the Village; and disruption to traffic circulation. Such fee shall be established by the Village Mayor on a case-by-case basis based on a reasonable evaluation of the relevant factors given the size of the film production and the extent and length of filming activities.
- D. The fees and costs described in subsections A, B and C above shall be paid in cash or certified check prior to the issuance of the permit. However, all or part of these fees and costs may be waived by the Village Clerk or Mayor in connection with filming done for a charitable, educational, public service or other similar non-profit purpose.

III. SEVERABILITY

The invalidity of any sentence, part or provision of this local law shall not affect the validity of any other part of the Local Law which can be given effect without such invalid part of parts.

IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall become effective immediately as provided in the Municipal Home Rule Law upon being filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.
