### CITY OF HAGERSTOWN, MARYLAND

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF HAGERSTOWN, AMENDING CHAPTER 60, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC BY (1) ADDING TO SECTION 37 MUNICIPAL LOTS A PENALTY FOR ILLEGALLY PARKING IN AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING SPACE; and (2) MODIFYING THE SCHEDULE OF FINES AT SECTION 51, PENALTIES

#### RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have enacted Chapter 60 Vehicles and Traffic of the City Code to regulate the operation and parking of vehicles within the corporate limits of the City of Hagerstown; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to amend the aforesaid Chapter 60 to (1) prohibit parking non-electric motor vehicles in spaces designated for charging of electric vehicles and requiring operators to remove electric vehicles promptly upon obtaining a full charge; (2) consolidating fines in Chapter 60 in one location; and (3) increasing the fine for parking in areas designated for work by City employees in performing construction, repair or cleaning of City streets;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it to be in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Hagerstown to do so;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hagerstown, Maryland, as its duly constituted legislative body, as follows:

See attached revisions, in italics, to Chapter 60. Except where noted, no change has been made to said Chapter.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the effective date of this Enacting Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, ENACTED AND ORDAINED that this Enacting Ordinance shall become effective at the expiration of thirty (30) calendar days following its approval.

# § 60-37. Municipal Lots.

- A. The fee or charge with respect to parking meters in municipal parking lots during the time that such parking meters are being operated shall be at the rate established by resolution by the Mayor and Council.
- B. In all lots that are not controlled by parking meters or any other mechanical devices, parking costs shall be in accordance with rates as determined by Mayor and Council.
- C. A person shall not park a motor vehicle in a space designated for charging of electric motor vehicles, unless that person is charging an electric motor vehicle. Promptly upon receiving a full charge, the person must remove the electric motor vehicle.

### § 60-51. Violations and penalties.

A. Any person who violates the provisions of Article II, Article IV, Article IVA or Article V and is convicted thereof shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$25, except as otherwise provided in Subsection B below.
