ORDINANCE #2057-2023

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE III, OF CHAPTER 70 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT, EXTRADUTY EMPLOYMENT" AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES HERETOFORE ADOPTED THE PROVISIONS OF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Hamilton that:

SECTION 1. § 70-16. Rates of compensation; administrative fee; payment for services is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 70-16. Rates of compensation; administrative fee; payment for services.

- A. The hourly rate of compensation to the Township for contracting the services of extra-duty law enforcement officers shall consist of the following:
- 1. The hourly rate of \$85.00 for the calendar year 2024, that rate increased in subsequent years by the annual percent increase in police officer salary authorized by Township Committee, and;
- 2. An hourly rate of \$22.91 for vehicle use that is determined by the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Schedule of Equipment Rates. This rate shall increase as new rate schedules are published, and;
- 3. An hourly rate of \$6.50 for Administrative functions including scheduling of officers for off-duty employment, maintenance of time records, payroll processing, and billing. This rate shall be increased annually in correlation with the PBA Collective Bargaining Unit's annual percentage increase.
 - a) If the township begins to utilize a third party firm to administer extra duty employment, the township's Administrative function fee will not be included; however, the third party firm Administrative fee will.

SECTION 2. Severability and Effectiveness Clause.

- (a) If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
- (b) Any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and publication as provided by law.
