AMENDED NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Harriman will hold a public hearing on Local Law Introductory # 2 of 2024, Chapter 132, Article VI, 132-42 Schedule VIII, at the Village of Harriman Village Hall, 12 Church Street, Harriman, New York on March 12, 2024 at 7:20 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard.

Local Law # 2 of the Year 2024

A local law to Amend Chapter 132, Article VI of the Village Code, §132-42, Schedule VIII, “Stop Intersections.”

SECTION 1. PURPOSE:

- A. This local law will amend Village Code Chapter 132, Article VI, § 132-42 Schedule VIII: “Stop Intersections” by adding to the list of stop intersections Melody Lane in the northeasterly direction of travel at its intersection with Brookside Drive West located in the Village of Harriman.
- B. The amendment is necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare by preventing unsafe and hazardous vehicular traffic conditions at this intersection located.

SECTION 2: AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 132, § 132- 42, Article VI, Schedule VIII

Chapter 132, § 132-42, Schedule VIII of the Village Code is amended by adding to the list of stop intersections Melody Lane in the northeasterly direction of travel at its intersection with Brookside Drive West located within the Village of Harriman as follows:

<u>Stop Sign on</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>	<u>At Intersection of</u>
Melody Lane	Northeasterly	Brookside Drive West

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This local law shall take effect upon posting and filing with the Secretary of State of New York.



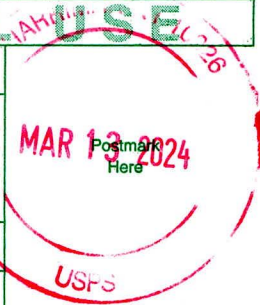
