INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW# 4 of 2024

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE WATER RATES FOR THE VILLAGE OF HARRIMAN

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Harriman, New York, has undertaken a review of the water rates for the Village of Harriman; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law §§ 10 and 20, the Village amends, enacts and deletes certain sections of Chapter 74 the Village of Harriman Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Harriman, County of Orange as follows:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE AND INTENT

The purpose of this local law is to increase certain water rates for the Village of Harriman to cover the costs of maintenance, operation, enlargement, improvement and debt service of the district. This local law shall be entitled, "A Local Law Amending the Water Rates for the Village of Harriman."

SECTION 2: CHANGES TO CHAPTER 74

Chapter 74-5 I(3)(a)[1]. Residential and commercial customers other than multifamily; plus, applicable meter service charge as set forth in this section and applicable fire protection fees in § 74-5 I (8): The water rate schedule is amended as follows:

In Village		Out of Village
Gallons	Rate	Rate
0-50k	4.96/K	12.41/K
51-100k	8.20/K	14.39/K
101-250k	11.66K	16.43/K
251k and over	14.00/K	18.54/K

Chapter 74-5-I(3)(a)[2]. Multifamily [more than two residential customers served through common meter(s)]: The water rate schedule is amended as follows:

In Village	Out of Village
6.17/K	14.91/K


