ORDINANCE NO. 856

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING PARTS OF ORDINANCE NO. 70 – “AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMPTON, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING THE REQUIREMENT FOR SERVICE CONNECTING SEWERS, THE CONNECTION CHARGES THEREFORE, ESTABLISHING SEWER RENTAL CHARGES AND PROVIDING FOR BILLING AND COLLECTING THEREOF FOR THE HAMPTON TOWNSHIP SEWER COLLECTION DISTRICT FOR ALL RESIDENTIAL AND NON-RESIDENTIAL USERS AND PROVIDING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS” AS AMENDED.

THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMPTON, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Article VI, Section 601 of Ordinance No. 70 of the Township of Hampton, as amended by Ordinances Nos. 325, 439, 464, 484, 491, 566, 631, 665, 715, 746, 757 and 822 is amended as follows:

Section 601(c). All owners of residential and/or non-residential property that have available the use of the sewerage system of the Hampton Township Sewer District shall pay to the Township a Sanitary Sewer Capital Fee. Sections (1) and (3) of 601(c) set forth in Ordinance No. 822 shall remain in effect. Section 601(c)(2) shall be amended as follows:

- a. For 2023, the Sanitary Sewer Capital Fee shall be set at Thirty-Eight (\$38.00) Dollars per month, or Seventy-Six (\$76.00) Dollars per sanitary sewer billing cycle;
- b. For 2024, the Sanitary Sewer Capital Fee shall be set at Forty-Three (\$43.00) Dollars per month, or Eighty-Six (\$86.00) Dollars per sanitary sewer billing cycle.

Article IX (repeated). If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this ordinance and each section,

subsection, sentence, clause and phrase hereof has been prepared, proposed, adopted, approved and ratified irrespective of the fact that any one or more other section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase be declared invalid or unconstitutional;

Article X (repeated). All ordinances or parts of ordinances insofar as they are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Article XI. The requirements of this ordinance shall become effective for any billing on or after the 2nd day of January 2023.
