ORDINANCE NO. 2019-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HOMESTEAD, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING CHAPTER 141 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HOMESTEAD TO ADD SECTION 141-4 PROVIDING FOR A BOROUGH TRANSPORTATION REIMBURSEMENT FOR HOMESTEAD VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT VOLUNTEERS RESPONDING TO FIRE CALLS IN THE BOROUGH OF HOMESTEAD

WHEREAS, the Borough of Homestead relies on the Homestead Volunteer Fire Department volunteers to provide valuable firefighting and other emergency services to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is authorized, pursuant to powers granted by Section 1202(35) of the Pennsylvania Borough Code to appropriate money for fire companies that service the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough deems it appropriate to provide the Homestead Volunteer Fire Department with nominal contribution amounts, to be set by resolution, to help cover the vehicle transportation related expenses incurred by its volunteer firefighters when responding to fire calls.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Homestead, County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ORDAINED and ENACTED by authority of same, that:

SECTION 1:

Chapter 141 of the Code of the Borough of Homestead is hereby amended to add the following section:

§ 141-4. FIRE DEPARTMENT CALL TRANSPORTATION CONTRIBUTION

- A. Homestead Volunteer Fire Department volunteer firefighters shall receive from the Borough of Homestead a response cost reimbursement, per fire call responded to in the Borough of Homestead by the volunteer firefighter as a contribution to help defray the costs of response vehicle fuel and maintenance. The specific reimbursement amount an individual firefighter will qualify for will be based on whether the firefighter is categorized as a firefighter with only minimum essential training, a level one certified firefighter, or a level two certified firefighters and shall be set by the Council of the Borough of Homestead by resolution.
- B. Reimbursements shall be made by the Borough only after receiving from the Chief of the Homestead Volunteer Fire Department written verification of the date, time and location of the volunteer fire fighter's fire-call response for which the volunteer fire fighter seeks payment as well as verification of the firefighter's certification status.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.




