AN ORDINANCE DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY AND
AUTHORIZING ITS SALE

WHEREAS, the Village of Homer Glen, Will County, Illinois (the “*Village*”) is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the “*Home Rule Powers*”); and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Homer Glen has the authority, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 to declare property to be no longer necessary or to be in the best interests of the Village and to authorize the sale of such property in such manner as the Village may designate; and

WHEREAS, the personal property itemized in the list attached hereto and incorporated herein as “Exhibit A” has been determined to be no longer necessary or to be in the best interests of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village President and Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Homer Glen, Will County, Illinois, by and through its Home Rule Powers, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The Board of Trustees of the Village of Homer Glen finds that the recitals set forth above are true and correct and includes the recitals in the Ordinance.

SECTION TWO: Authorization - Pursuant to the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village of Homer Glen hereby declares that the personal property itemized in the list attached hereto and incorporated herein as “Exhibit A” is no longer necessary or to be in the best interests of the Village and that such property may be sold in a manner approved by the Village Manager.

SECTION THREE: Severability - The various portions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly declared to be severable, and the invalidity of any such portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portions of this Ordinance, which shall be enforced to the fullest extent possible.

SECTION FOUR: Repealer - All Ordinances or portions of Ordinances previously passed or adopted by the Village of Homer Glen that conflict with or are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE: Effective Date - This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
