BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HOLLISTER, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The owners of an adjacent piece of property have petitioned the Board of Aldermen for the vacation of said land.
- 2. The absolute authority to vacate streets in Hollister, Missouri, is vested in the Board of Aldermen by section 88.673 RSMo.
- 3. Section 88.673 RSMo provides that in the event of such vacation of any streets in Hollister that lands thus vacated shall revert to the owners of the adjacent lots and proportioned as it was taken from them.
- 4. The Board of Aldermen finds that it is in the public interest for that part of said street to be vacated and that it will harm no person or deprive no person of access.
