AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 525.140 PENALTIES OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF HOLLISTER, MISSOURI.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HOLLISTER, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 525.140 Penalties

The Building Official or designee shall be able to remove signage within forty-eight (48) hours after informing any person, persons, firms, partnership or corporation, if found not in compliance with Sections 525.035 B, 525.040 B, 525.050 B, 525.060 B and 525.070 C.

Any person, persons, firm, partnership, or corporation violating any provisions of remaining signs pertaining to Chapter 525 shall upon conviction thereof be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day this Chapter 525 or any part thereof is violated shall be and constitute a separate offense and violations of this Article for which they may be punished.

Section 525.140 Penalties

Any person, persons, firm, partnership, or corporation violating any provisions of remaining signs pertaining to Chapter 525 shall upon conviction thereof be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day this Chapter 525 or any part thereof is violated shall be and constitute a separate offense and violations of this Article for which they may be punished.
