# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 525.140 PENALTIES OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF HOLLISTER, MISSOURI.

# BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HOLLISTER, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

#### Section 525.140 Penalties

A. The Building Official or designee shall be able to remove campaign and ballot initiative signage forty-eight (48) hours after informing any person, persons, firms, partnership or corporation, or forty-eight (48) hours attempted, unsuccessful contact with any person, persons, firms, partnership or corporation, if found not in compliance with Section 525.085 Campaign and Ballot Initiative Section.

B. Any person, persons, firm, partnership, or corporation violating any provisions of remaining signs pertaining to Chapter 525 shall upon conviction thereof be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day this Chapter 525 or any part thereof is violated shall be and constitute a separate offense and violations of this Article for which they may be punished.

# Chapter 525 Sign Code

### Section 525.140 Penalties

<u>A.</u> The Building Official or designee shall be able to remove signage <u>campaign and ballot</u> <u>initiative</u> signage within forty-eight (48) hours after informing any person, persons, firms, partnership or corporation, <u>or forty-eight (48) hours attempted, unsuccessful contact with</u> <u>any person, persons, firms, partnership or corporation, if</u> found not in compliance with <u>Section 525.085 Campaign and Ballot Initiative Section.</u> Sections 525.035 B, 525.040 B, 525.050 B, 525.060 B and 525.070 C.

**<u>B.</u>** Any person, persons, firm, partnership, or corporation violating any provisions of remaining signs pertaining to Chapter 525 shall upon conviction thereof be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day this Chapter 525 or any part thereof is violated shall be and constitute a separate offense and violations of this Article for which they may be punished.
