## AN ORDINANCE concerning

## **Utilities Charges Late Payment Charge**

FOR the purpose of establishing a certain late payment charge for delinquent quarterly water, sewer and waste collection charges; and all matters generally related thereto.

BY adding
Chapter 140 – Water and Sewers
Article V, Utility Bills
Sections 140-28
Code of the Town of Indian Head
(1990 Edition as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN HEAD, That new Section 140-28 is added to the Code of the Town of Indian Head (1990 Edition, as amended), Article V, Utility Bills, to follow immediately after Section 140-27 and to read as follows:

#### **CHAPTER 140 - WATER AND SEWERS**

#### **ARTICLE V. UTILITY BILLS**

## 140-28 LATE PAYMENT CHARGE.

CHARGES FOR WATER, SEWER AND WASTE COLLECTION SHALL BE BILLED QUARTERLY. EACH QUARTER'S CHARGES ARE DUE AND PAYABLE UPON RECEIPT. ANY QUARTER'S CHARGES NOT PAID WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS AFTER THE BILLING DATE ARE SUBJECT TO A LATE PAYMENT CHARGE IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN PERCENT (10%) OF THE AMOUNT OF THE QUARTERLY CHARGES.

**SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that all ordinances or parts of ordinances and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, that this Ordinance shall become effective at the expiration of twenty (20) calendar days after its approval by the Council.
