**AN ORDINANCE** concerning

**Removal and Disposal of Animal Waste**

**FOR** the purpose of revising requirements for the removal and disposal of animal waste; and all matters generally related thereto.

**BY** repealing and reenacting, with amendments  
Chapter 74 – Health and Sanitation  
Article III, Litter  
Section 74-24  
Code of the Town of Indian Head  
(1990 Edition as amended)

**SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN HEAD,** That Section 74-24 of the Code of the Town of Indian Head (1990 Edition, as amended), Chapter 74 - Health and Sanitation, Article III, Litter, is repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

**CHAPTER 74 – Health and Sanitation**

**Article III. Litter**


**74-24. Removal of animal waste.**

((It shall be the duty of the owner of any animal to remove such animal's feces from the property of others.)) **AN OWNER OR PERSON HAVING CONTROL OF A DOMESTIC**

ANIMAL SHALL NOT ALLOW THE ANIMAL TO DEFECATE ON PUBLIC PROPERTY OR PRIVATE PROPERTY NOT BELONGING TO THE OWNER OR PERSON HAVING CONTROL WITHOUT HAVING IN THE PERSON'S POSSESSION A SUITABLE CONTAINER FOR THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF THE WASTE. THE OWNER OR PERSON HAVING CONTROL OF THE ANIMAL MUST REMOVE IMMEDIATELY ANY WASTE DEPOSITED BY THE ANIMAL AND DISPOSE OF THE WASTE IN A PROPER AND SANITARY MANNER. A violation of this section ((shall constitute)) IS a municipal infraction. (See § 74-30.).

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, that this Ordinance shall become effective at the expiration of twenty (20) calendar days after its approval by the Council.
