Section 1.

Nothing herein shall be construed to abrogate the authority of the Village Board to impose measures to ensure the safety and privacy of visitors and employees while conducting business at Village of Island Park facilities.

The Village Board hereby designates certain areas of Village Hall as nonpublic forums, including the Office of the Village Clerk and the private offices of Village employees.

Accordingly, members of the public are prohibited from unauthorized entry, audio recording, videotaping and still photography in any areas designated as nonpublic forum.

Section 2. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
