1	AN ORDINANCE RENEWING THE PURCHASE OF THE LICENSING				
2	FEE FOR GRAYKEY FORENSIC SOFTWARE FROM GRAYSHIFT, LLC AND				
3	TO AUTHORIZE THE APPROVAL OF THE RENEWAL OF THE PURCHASE				
4	FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF THE SHERIFF.				
5	WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance 22-0149 Jefferson County, Missouri				
6	purchased the GrayKey forensic software along with the training courses from Grayshift				
7	LLC who is the sole source manufacturer and provider of the GrayKey forensic software				
8	and training; and				
9	WHEREAS, Pursuant to Ordinance 23-0145 was approved for the renewal of the				
10	licensing fee; and				
11	WHEREAS, Jefferson County, Missouri, (hereafter, the "County") recommends				
12	the renewal of the licensing fee for an additional one-year term:				
13	WHEREAS, GrayKey is a proprietary product that is internally developed and				
14	manufactured only by Grayshift, LLC; and				
15	WHEREAS, GrayKey is only available to government agencies that include law				
16	enforcement, public safety, and national defense agencies in select counties; and				
17	WHEREAS, GrayKey can extract more data from locked and encrypted mobile				
18	devices on site at your own department all while maintaining chain of custody; and				

1	WHEREAS, GrayKey offers a scalable digital forensic solution that can meet the				
2	demand of any size law enforcement agency; and				
3	WHEREAS, the GrayKey software can assist with the prioritization of obtained				
4	devices for data extraction; and				
5	WHEREAS, the GrayKey software integrates with existing forensic analysis				
6	products; and				
7	WHEREAS, the Jefferson County, Missouri, Council finds it is in the best interests				
8	of the County to approve the renewal request to renew the annual licensing fee with				
9	GrayKey forensic software along with the training courses from the sole-source vendor,				
10	Grayshift, LLC, for a term from date of approval to 3-10-25 for the total amount up to				
11	\$33,105.00 subject to budgetary limitations.				
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE JEFFERSON COUNTY,				
13	MISSOURI, COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS:				
14	Section 1. The County approves the requested purchase of the GrayKey				
15	forensic software along with the training courses from the sole-source vendor, Grayshift,				
16	LLC, for a term from the date of approval to 3-10-25 for the total amount up to \$33,105.00				
17	subject to budgetary limitations.				
18	Section 2. The Jefferson County, Missouri, Council hereby authorizes the				
19	County Executive to execute a renewal agreement, attached hereto and incorporated herein				
20	by reference and attached as Exhibit A. The County Executive is further authorized to take				
21	any and all actions necessary to carry out the intent of this Ordinance.				

- Section 3. Copies of all Invitations for Bid, Requests for Proposals, responses thereto, and any contracts or agreements shall be maintained by the Department of the County Clerk consistent with the rules and procedures for the maintenance and retention of records as promulgated by the Secretary of State.
