1 **AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO**
2 **EXECUTE CHANGE ORDER NO. 2 FOR THE ELECTRONIC MONITORING**
3 **SERVICES CONTRACT CT196600001 FOR THE 23RD JUDICIAL CIRCUIT**
4 **COURT- FAMILY COURT, THE JUVENILE OFFICE.**

5 **WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Ordinance 21-0442, Jefferson County, Missouri, and the
6 Juvenile Office entered into a Contract, known as the Electronic Monitoring Services
7 Contract CT196600001, with BI Incorporated; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance 23-0229 approved Change Order No. 1 to add \$12,000.00 to
9 the Electronic Monitoring Services Contract to cover the increased cost; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the Juvenile Office of Jefferson County, Missouri believes that it is
11 now necessary to adjust the estimated amount of the Electronic Monitoring Services
12 Contract; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the needed adjustment is to cover the cost for the remaining three
14 months of the contract; and

15 **WHEREAS**, there have been more juveniles placed on GPS monitoring systems than
16 in the past; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Juvenile Office for Jefferson County hereby requests an increase of
18 an additional Twelve Thousand Dollars (**\$12,000.00**) to the Electronic Monitoring Services
19 Contract CT1916600001 with BI Incorporated to cover the increased cost; and,

1 **WHEREAS** Jefferson County, Missouri, Council finds that it is now necessary and
2 in the best interest of the County to execute Change Order No. 2 to the Electronic
3 Monitoring Services CT 196600001 Contract with BI Incorporated, for an increase of
4 Twelve Thousand Dollars (**\$12,000.00**) to the contract sum, subject to budgetary limitations;
5 for a revised total of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (**\$35,000.00**) for the Electronic
6 Monitoring Services Contract Services CT19660001 upon approval.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE JEFFERSON COUNTY, MISSOURI, COUNCIL,
AS FOLLOWS:**

7 Section 1. The Contract with BI Incorporated for the Electronic Monitoring
8 Services Contract CT19660001 shall be increased by Twelve Thousand Dollars (**\$12,000.00**)
9 for a revised total cost of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (**\$35,000.00**), subject to budgetary
10 limitations.

11 Section 2. The Jefferson County, Missouri, Council hereby authorizes the County
12 Executive to execute Change Order No. 2 to the Electronic Monitoring Services Contract
13 CT196600001 with BI Incorporated, and any agreements or contracts necessary to effectuate
14 the award of the bids and proposals set forth in this Ordinance. The County Executive is
15 further authorized to take any and all actions necessary to carry out the intent of this
16 Ordinance.

17 Section 3. Copies of all Invitations for Bid, response thereto, any contract
18 agreements and change orders shall be maintained by the Department of the County Clerk
19 consistent with the rules and procedures for the maintenance and retention of records as
20 promulgated by the Secretary of State.

1 Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date
2 of approval. If any part of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not
3 affect the remainder of this Ordinance.


