

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO THE TRAFFIC ON THE PUBLIC STREETS OF THE CITY OF KINGSTON, NEW YORK, LOWERING THE SPEED LIMIT TO 15 MPH ON WEBSTER STREET**

**WHEREAS**, in the interest of safety and the needs of the residents, speed limits on the street must be regulated.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KINGSTON, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1-** Article 7, SECTION 390-52, SCHEDULE XII, "SPEED LIMIT" is hereby amended by ADDING the following:

"15 MPH SPEED LIMIT" is to be ADDED at 25 Webster Street


**SECTION 2-** All ordinances and parts thereof, inconsistent herewith are hereby appealed

**SECTION 3-** This resolution shall take place immediately after passage, approval and publication as provided by law.





