WHEREAS, in the interest of safety and the needs of the residents, parking on the street must be regulated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KINGSTON, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1- Article XII, SECTION 390-61, SCHEDULE XVII, "LIMITED TIME PARKING" is hereby amended by ADDING the following:

"NO PARKING MON-FRI 7AM-4PM" is to be ADDED on Merilina Avenue to the intersection of Voorhees Avenue

SECTION 2- All ordinances and parts thereof, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed


SECTION 3- This resolution shall take place immediately after passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
