**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF KINGSTON, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY, EXTENDING THE TAX FILING DEADLINE FOR THE MERCANTILE TAX UNTIL MAY 17, 2021**

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Kingston imposes a Mercantile Tax pursuant to Section 181 – 43 et seq of the Kingston Code, and;

**WHEREAS**, the annual Mercantile Tax is paid on the annual gross volume of business for the proceeding calendar year, and;


**WHEREAS**, the Federal and State filing date for Income Taxes has been extended to May 17, 2021, and;

**WHEREAS**, Kingston wishes to extend the deadline for filing of the 2020 Mercantile Taxes to May 17, 2021 as well.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Town Council of the Municipality of Kingston approves the extension of the filing deadline for the 2020 Mercantile Tax until May 17, 2021.
