

RESOLUTION 2023 – 11

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF KINGSTON, LUZERNE COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY, APPROVING
EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC CONTROLS AND REGULATIONS TO
PLACE STOP SIGNS ON TIOGA AVENUE AT REYNOLDS
STREET**

WHEREAS, the Kingston Municipal Code, at Section 170 – 14 grants to the Mayor, with approval of the Council and upon notice to the Council, the authority to designate experimental traffic and/or parking regulations and to designate such locations with proper signs and markings for periods of time not to exceed ninety (90) days; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor wishes to establish experimental traffic regulations related to placing stop signs on Tioga Avenue as follows:

1. Municipal Code Section 170 – 22 A is amended to install a stop sign to control traffic traveling north on Tioga Avenue at the intersection with Reynolds Street and a stop sign to control traffic traveling south on Tioga Avenue at the intersection of Reynolds Street.


2. Violation of the foregoing experimental traffic regulations shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Municipal Code Section 170 – 22 B.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Town Council of the Municipality of Kingston does hereby approve the establishment of experimental traffic controls and regulations as set forth in this Resolution for a period not to be in excess of ninety (90) days. It is further resolved and directed that signage be installed to facilitate these regulations.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
