

RESOLUTION 2023 – 12

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF KINGSTON, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY, APROOVING EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC CONTROLS AND REGULATIONS ON TIOGA AVENUE

WHEREAS, The Kingston Municipal Code, at Section 170 – 14 grants to the Mayor, with approval of the Council and upon notice to the Council, the authority to designate experimental traffic and/or parking regulations and to designate such locations with proper signs and markings for periods of time not to exceed ninety (90) days; and,

WHEREAS, The Mayor wishes to establish experimental traffic regulations as follows:


Section 170 – 25 related to prohibited parking is amended to prohibit parking on the west side of Tioga Avenue between the north driveway access to the Luzerne Intermediate Unit at 368 Tioga Avenue and the south driveway access to said building between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED, that the Town Council of the Municipality of Kingston does hereby approve the establishment of experimental parking restrictions on Tioga Avenue for a period not to be in excess of ninety (90) days.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
