

RESOLUTION 2023 – 4

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF KINGSTON, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY, APPROVING EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC CONTROLS AND REGULATIONS TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON THE WEST SIDE OF NORTH LOVELAND AVENUE FOR A DISTANCE OF 25 FEET IN A SOUTHERLY DIRECTION ON NORTH LOVELAND AVENUE FROM CHESTER STREET

WHEREAS, the Kingston Municipal Code, at Section 170 – 14 grants to the Mayor, with notice to the Council and approval of the Council, the authority to designate experimental traffic and/or parking regulations and to designate such locations with proper signs and markings for periods of time not to exceed ninety (90) days; and,


WHEREAS, the Mayor wishes to establish experimental traffic regulations to prohibit parking on the west side of North Loveland Avenue for a distance of 25 feet in a Southerly direction from the intersection of North Loveland Avenue with Chester Street and thereby add the designated area to the controls of Municipal Code Section 170 – 25.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Council of the Municipality of Kingston does hereby approve the establishment of experimental traffic controls and regulations as set forth in this Resolution for a period not to be in excess of ninety (90) days. It is further resolved and directed that signage be installed to facilitate these regulations.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
