LOCAL LAW NUMBER 1-2024 OF THE VILLAGE OF LARCHMONT

A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR THE PROHIBITION OF DOGS FROM FLINT PARK

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Larchmont, Westchester County, New York, as follow:

Section 1: Chapter 203 of the Code of the Village of Larchmont is hereby amended by repealing Section 203-3 “Penalties for offenses.” and adding thereto a new Section 203-3 to read as follows:

§ 203-3. **Dogs prohibited.**

It shall be unlawful for any person to enter or be present in Flint Park with any dog. This section shall not apply to a service animal who is accompanying an individual with a disability in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Section 2: Chapter 203 of the Code of the Village of Larchmont is hereby amended to add thereto a new Section 203-4 to read as follows:

§ 203-4. **Penalties for offenses.**

Any person committing an offense against this chapter shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine not exceeding \$250 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 15 days, or to both such fine and imprisonment. The continuation of an offense against the provisions of this chapter shall constitute, for each day the offense is continued, a separate and distinct offense hereunder.

Section 3: Severability. If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this Local Law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate distinct and independent portion. Such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which other portions shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4: This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
