ORDINANCE NO. 2021-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LEET, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING SECTION 2 PARAGRAPH A OF ORDINANCE NO. 2015-05 OF THE LEET TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the Leet Township Board of Commissioners ordained and enacted Ordinance 2015-05 allowing residents to keep chickens; and,

WHEREAS, the Leet Township Board of Commissioners have determined that it would be beneficial to the Residents of Leet Township to increase the number of chicken permitted from 4 to 8.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted as follows:

Section 2-403 paragraph A of Ordinance No. 2015-05 is stricken in its entirety and in lieu thereof the following language is substituted:

- “A. No residence shall contain at any one time more than eight hens over the age of one month.
- (1) In the case of two-family dwellings, conversion dwellings, or multi-family dwellings without individually owned backyards, the maximum number of hens allowed is eight per property.”
