**ORDINANCE NO. 614**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER SWATARA, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING PART 2 (TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) OF CHAPTER 15 (MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), SECTION 15-205 (TURNING PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED); AND SECTION 15-301 (RESTRICTIONS ON SIZE, WEIGHT AND TYPE OF VEHICLE AND LOAD) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF LOWER SWATARA TOWNSHIP TO PROHIBIT TRUCKS EXCEEDING FORTY (40) FEET FROM TURNING ON TO HIGHSPIRE ROAD FROM FULLING MILL ROAD.

SECTION 1. Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Part 2, Traffic Regulations, Section 15-205, Turning Prohibited or Restricted, and Section 15-301, Restrictions on Size, Weight and Type of Vehicle and Load, is amended as follows by deleting text that is shown as struck and adding the underlined text with ellipses to indicate text that is remaining unchanged:

**§ 15-205 Turning Prohibited or Restricted.**

1. It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle of the type indicated traveling upon the first-named street at any of the following intersections, in the direction or directions indicated in each case, to make a left turn and/or a right turn into the second-named street, as indicated, at any time when such a turn is prohibited by this section:

3. The Township is authorized to erect or cause to be erected any signs necessary to effect the restrictions of this Section.

**§ 15-301 Restrictions on Size, Weight and Type of Vehicle Load.**

1. On the following bridges and streets or parts of streets, by authority granted by § 4902(a) of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, 75 Pa.C.S.A. § 4902(a), with the exception of emergency vehicles (such as EMS, EMA, police and fire) it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to drive any vehicle or combination having a length, type of vehicle load, or gross weight in excess of the maximum prescribed below for that bridge or street or part of a street, as case may be, except for when in the process of making a residential delivery within the restricted zone:

3. The Township is authorized to erect or cause to be erected any signs necessary to effect the restrictions of this Section.

SECTION 2. Except only as amended, modified and changed herein, Chapter 15 of the Township of Lower Swatara Code of Ordinances as originally enacted and as previously amended shall remain in all other respects in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. If any section, sub-section, provision, regulation, limitation, restriction, sentence, clause, phrase or word in this Ordinance is declared by any reason to be illegal, unconstitutional, or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect or impair the validity of this Ordinance or Chapter 15 of the Code as a whole, or any other section, sub-section, provision, regulation, limitation, restriction, sentence, clause, phrase, word or remaining portion of this Ordinance or Chapter 15 of the Code. The Township Board of Commissioners hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance and each section, sub-section, phrase and word thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the sections, sub-sections, provisions, regulations, limitations, restrictions, sentences, clauses, phrases or words may be declared illegal, unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with applicable law.


