Ordinance #334

Add the following to section 118-1:

§ 118-1 Definitions and interpretation.

A. Words and phrases, when used in this chapter, shall have the meanings **as defined in this section or as** ascribed to them in the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania, as now in force, or as hereafter amended, enacted or reenacted, [1] except where context clearly indicates a different meaning.

SIDEWALK

That portion of a street between curb lines, or the lateral lines of a roadway, and the adjacent property lines, intended for use by pedestrians.

STREET

A strip of land, including the entire right-of-way, intended for use as means of vehicular and pedestrian circulation. This includes the term highway as referred to in this chapter.

STREET WIDTH

The shortest distance between the lines delineating the right-of-way of a street.

Add the following to section 118-25:

§ 118-25. Parking prohibited at all times.

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the **streets or highways**, or parts thereof described below.

Name of Highway	Side	Location
Pennsylvania Avenue	West	From Seventh Street to Tenth Street.

This Ordinance shall be incorporated into and be part of the Ordinance of the Borough of Matamoras effective immediately. Approved this 9th *day* of April, 2019.
