## Local Law 4 of 2021

## Chapter 99, Building Construction ; "NYStretch"

Section 1. That Chapter 99, entitled "Building Construction" of the Code of the Town of Marbletown, as amended, is further amended to include the following provisions:

## 99-1(A)(1). Legislative Intent

The Town of Marbletown seeks to protect and promote the public health, safety, and welfare of its residents by mandating energy efficient building standards. In 2019, the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA) developed and published the NYStretch Energy Code 2020 (hereinafter referred to as NYStretch), a more energy efficient building code than the 2020 ECCCNYS. This proposed code amendment seeks to modify the Marbletown Town Code to adopt NYStretch and to enact more restrictive regulations as they relate to new or substantially renovated buildings.

## 59-1(A)(2). Adoption of NYStretch Code

Effective October 1, 2021 the NYStretch Energy Code 2020, published by the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (hereafter referred to as "NYStretch"), shall be applicable to all new construction and substantial renovations in the Town of Marbletown.

## 59-1(A)(3). Authority

The proposed local law is enacted pursuant to New York Energy Law §11-109(1), and Municipal Home Rule Law §10 and in accordance with the procedures detailed in Municipal Home Rule § 20.

## Section 2.

This local law shall be filed with the state fire prevention and building code council within thirty days after its adoption.

## Section 3.

This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State pursuant to New York Energy Law §11-109(1) and the Municipal Home Rule Law.

## RESOLUTION#53-2021 STRETCH ENERGY CODE

**WHEREAS**, to prevent a statewide patchwork of stricter energy codes, the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA) developed the NYStretch Energy Code – 2020 (NYStretch);

WHEREAS, a stretch energy code is simply an energy code that is more stringent than the minimum base energy code that can be voluntarily adopted by local jurisdictions. NYStretch is a voluntary supplement to the 2020 Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State (2020 ECCCNYS) improves its efficiency an average of ten to twelve percent (10-12 %) more efficient than the minimum requirements of the base energy code, the 2020 Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State (2020 ECCCNYS);

WHEREAS, some New York State municipalities have adopted stricter energy standards to ensure reduced energy costs for its residents and businesses;

WHEREAS, under NY Energy Law § 11-109, the Town of Marbletown is authorized to adopt a local energy code more stringent that the 2020 ECCCNYS;

# WHEREAS, the Town Board is considering amending provisions of the Town Code Chapter #99 to add provisions for a local energy code "NYStretch"; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on May 18, 2021, at which time all persons either for or against said amendments were heard; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board is declared Lead Agency for the purposes of environmental review with respect to the proposed resolution, in accordance with Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law of the State of New York, and the regulations promulgated thereunder at 6 NYCRR 617 (collectively, "SEQRA"); and

WHEREAS, the Marbletown Town Board, as Lead Agency, has advised that the proposed action meets the criteria of a "Type II Action" under SEQRA; now, therefore, be it further
