

BOROUGH OF MARS, BUTLER COUNTY
ORDINANCE NO. 438

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MARS, BUTLER COUNTY,
ESTABLISHING A MANDATORY RETIRMENT AGE OF 65 FOR ALL
BOROUGH OF MARS EMPLOYEES.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of Mars, Butler County, Pennsylvania,
as follows:

WHEREAS, by authority vested in the Borough by virtue of the Act of April 18,
2014, as amended, known as the Borough Code, under Title 8, Section 1171, the
Borough may enact a mandatory retirement age; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined that it is in the best interest of the
Borough and the public to enact a mandatory retirement age of 65 years old for all
employees of the Borough.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, ENACTED AND ADOPTED by the
Council of the Borough of Mars:

1. All employees of the Borough, including police officers and non-uniformed
personnel, having attained the age of 65 shall, on the anniversary date of employment
with the Borough which anniversary shall occur subsequent to said employee's 65th
birthday, be retired from employment with the Borough and shall be ineligible to serve
thereafter as a police officer or employee of the Borough.

2. Nothing contained herein shall be construed so as to interfere, contradict,
change or amend any other ordinance regarding pension funds and minimum periods of
total service therein and all minimum ages at which police officers or other employees
may be retired; provided, however, that the retirement age designated herein shall be
mandatory.
