## CITY OF MARION, WAUPACA COUNTY, WISCONSIN AN ORDINANCE CREATING SECTION NO. 625 (AMENDMENT TO ZONING MAP AND ORDINANCE)

WHEREAS, the City received from the property owner, Barry May, a request/application to rezone that property located at 1440 Magolski Road, Marion WI, from Manufacturing District to the B-2 Highway Business District in order to allow outside storage (warehousing) of campers, boats and vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Plan Commission of the City of Marion held a public hearing on the  $9^{\text{th}}$  day of August, 2023, following the required notices and pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 62.23(7) (d) 2; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission made its recommendation in favor of rezoning the below described property as requested.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Marion does ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1:</u> Ordinance No. 2023-004 is hereby created to provide that the following described property shall be and the same is hereby rezoned from the Manufacturing District and hereby designated to become hereafter a part of the B-2 Highway Business District. <u>Section 4</u>: All Ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 5:</u> This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and publication as required by law.
