AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARSHFIELD, MISSOURI, ADOPTING THE 2017 EDITION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE., REGULATING AND GOVERNING THE CONDITIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF ALL PROPERTY, BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES; BY PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF SAID CODE OF MARSHFIELD, MISSOURI; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND COLLECTION OF FEES THEREFOR; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2104 OF THE CITY OF MARSHFIELD, MISSOURI AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF THE ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MARSHFIELD, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a certain document, one (1) copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Marshfield, Missouri, being marked and designated as the National Electrical Code 2017 edition, as published by the National Electrical Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Electrical Code of the City of Marshfield, Missouri, for regulating and governing the conditions and maintenance of all property, buildings and structures; by providing for the administration of said code of Marshfield, Missouri; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Electrical Code on file in the office of the City of Marshfield, Missouri are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this ordinance except such portions thereof as are hereinafter deleted, modified, or amended.

Section 2. Section 210.12 Arc-Fault Circuit-Interrupter Protection to be modified to read (A) Dwelling Units. All 120-volt, single phase, 15- and 20-ampere branch circuits supplying outlets or devises installed in dwelling unit kitchens, family rooms, dining rooms, living rooms, parlors, libraries, dens, bedrooms, sunrooms, recreation rooms, closets, hallways, laundry areas, or similar rooms or areas shall be protected by any of the means described in 210.12(A)(1) through (6).

Section 3. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Board of Aldermen hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause of phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases to be declared unconstitutional.

Section 4. This ordinance and the rules, regulations, provisions, requirements, orders and matters established and adopted hereby shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the date of its final passage and adoption.
