

**A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE THE OFFICIAL INTENT OF
THE CITY OF MARYVILLE, MISSOURI.**


WHEREAS, the City of Maryville, Missouri (the "City") intends to finance the costs of acquiring, constructing, installing, improving, furnishing and equipping various projects throughout the City, including without limitation the projects listed on **Exhibit A** attached hereto (collectively, the "Projects").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARYVILLE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council hereby finds it necessary and declares its intent to finance the costs of the Projects. The City has made, or expects to make, expenditures in connection with the Projects. The City may reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of a tax-exempt financing by, or on behalf of, the City. The maximum principal amount of the tax-exempt financing expected to be issued for the Projects is \$5,500,000.

EXHIBIT A

PROJECTS

1. Acquisition and construction of a Downtown Pavilion
2. Acquisition and construction of a Downtown Pedestrian Alleyway Project
3. Acquisition, construction and improvement of stormwater infrastructure
4. Construction, improvement and installation of the South Main Corridor Improvement Project, Phase II, and other roadway or traffic signal improvements
5. Construction, improvement, installation, and equipping of projects at Mozingo Lake Recreation Park, including but not limited to the Mozingo North RV Expansion and the Mozingo Visitor's Center
6. Acquisition, construction, improvement, installation, and equipping of various City Parks and Recreation projects, including but not limited to the following:
 - a. Beal Park Complex & Donaldson Westside Park ballpark renovations
 - b. Judah Park bridge replacement and park improvements
 - c. Sunrise Bark Dog Park improvements
 - d. Beal Park tennis court conversion to pickleball courts
 - e. Donaldson Westside Park and Maryville Community Center entrance drives, parking and trails improvements
