ORDINANCE No. 2023/06/05-1

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING HOURS OF OPERATION FOR SALE OF LIQUOR AND AMENDING § 163-14 OF THE CITY OF MAROA CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS by City Ordinance § 163-14 **Hours of Operation**, the times allowed for licensed establishments to sell and/or serve alcoholic beverages shall be set from time to time by the City Council;

WHEREAS § 163-14 **Hours of Operation** was previously amended by ordinances 2017/10/23-2 and 2017/11/27-3;

WHEREAS the previous changes to § 163-14 **Hours of Operation** have been determined to create an unnecessary financial burden towards retailers, given the increasing number of consumers who work alternate shifts, etc.;

WHEREAS the City of Maroa has determined it is in the interest of the City to modify its Ordinances dealing with hours of operation for licensed establishments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Maroa, Macon County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. § 163-14 **Hours of Operation** is hereby modified (text removed shall be indicated by strikethrough and text add shall be indicated by underline) as follows:

§ 163-14 Hours of Operation.

~~All licensees may sell or permit to be sold on or in their licensed premises alcoholic liquors between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. the following day. Alcoholic liquors shall not be sold or consumed after 2:00 a.m.; with the exception of New Year's Eve, when alcoholic liquors maybe sold and consumed upon the premises until 3:00 a.m. on January 1. Alcoholic liquors shall not be sold or consumed after 2:00 a.m. on Sunday, except between the hours of 12:00 noon and 10:00 p.m.~~

§ 163-14 Hours of Operation.

Alcoholic products may only be sold or consumed in appropriately licensed establishments during the following times:

Monday 6:00 a.m. – Tuesday 2:00 a.m.

Tuesday 6:00 a.m. – Wednesday 2:00 a.m.

Wednesday 6:00 a.m. – Thursday 2:00 a.m.

Thursday 6:00 a.m. – Friday 2:00 a.m.

Friday 6:00 a.m. – Saturday 2:00 a.m.

Saturday 6:00 a.m. – Sunday 2:00 a.m.


Sunday 10:00 a.m. – Sunday 10:00 p.m.

Sunday, December 31st 10:00 a.m – Monday, January 1st 2:00 a.m.


