ORDINANCE NO. 1175

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MECHANICSBURG
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA,
AMENDING CHAPTER 15, PART 2, SECTION 15-206, OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES FOR THE BOROUGH OF MECHANICSBURG FOR THE
PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A FOUR-WAY STOP INTERSECTION AT
THE INTERSECTION OF NORWAY STREET AND SHARON AVENUE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to general authority granted under Section 1202 of the Borough Code, 8 Pa.C.S.A. §1202 to make regulations as may be necessary to protect the health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the community, Council has the authority to regulate the flow of vehicular traffic within Borough-owned public rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is reasonable and appropriate to create a four-way stop intersection at the intersection of Norway Street and Sharon Avenue for the purpose controlling increased traffic volume attributable to the commercial and residential land development occurring in Legacy Park which connects to Norway Street; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to amend Chapter 15, Part 2, Section 15-206 of the Code of Ordinances for the Borough of Mechanicsburg for the purpose of establishing a four-way intersection at the intersection of Norway Street and Sharon Avenue.

BE IT ENACTED ADOPTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby enacted, adopted and ordained by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mechanicsburg, County of Cumberland, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. **Background.** The background set forth above is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. **Amendment.**

(a) The first paragraph of Chapter 15, Part 2, Section 15-206 of the Code of Ordinances for the Borough of Mechanicsburg is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 15-206 **Stop Intersections Established.**

The following intersections are hereby established as stop intersections, and except in the case of four-way stop intersections official stop signs shall be erected (or are hereby confirmed if heretofore erected) in such a position as to face traffic approaching the second-named street upon the first-named street, in the direction or directions hereby indicated. In the case of four-way stop intersections, official stop signs shall be erected (or are hereby confirmed if heretofore erected) in such a position as to face traffic approaching the intersection from all directions. All

vehicles and tractors approaching any such intersection upon a street having thereon erected an official stop sign at said intersection shall come to a full stop, within a reasonable distance, before entering such intersection:

(b) The Table identified as “Four-Way Stop Intersections” in Chapter 15, Part 2, Section 15-206 of the Code of Ordinances for the Borough of Mechanicsburg is hereby amended by adding thereto the following four-way stop intersection:

Section 3. **Severability.** If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such action shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. **Repealer.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances that are inconsistent herewith are repealed.

Section 5. **Saving Clause.** Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court; or affect any rights, or any cause of action, nor shall legal right or remedy be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 6. **Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
