

**ORD. 08-21-23B**  
**Amending Chapter 221, Article III, Section 12**

**WHEREAS** the City of Mendota believes it to be in the best interest of its residents to control and have knowledge of those persons going door to door selling merchandise and services,

**BE IT ORDAINED** that the following changes and additions are to be made to Chapter 221, Article III. The following definitions shall be added or changed to read:

**Chapter 221, ARTICLE II is to be deleted in its entirety. Any such Itinerant Merchant shall be registered in the City of Mendota under the Contractor Registration Ordinance.**

**221-12 Issuance and revocation of certificate of registrations.**

Upon receipt of the application required by this article, there will be an investigation of the applicant's business and moral character and criminal history.

- D. Any certificate of registration issued hereunder shall be revoked by the city clerk or his/her designee or chief of police or his/her designee if the holder of the certificate is convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this article, or has made a false statement in the application, or otherwise has been disqualified for the issuance of a certificate of registration under the terms of this article.
- E. Any certificate of registration issued hereunder shall be revoked by the city clerk or his/her designee or chief of police or his/her designee if the holder of the certificate receives 3 or more substantiated complaints.
- F. Immediately upon such verbal revocation a written notice thereof shall be given by the chief of police or his/her designee to the holder of the certificate in person or by United States mail addressed to the address set forth in the application. Immediately upon the mailing or serving of such notice the certificate of registration shall become null and void.
- G. Registration fees may be prorated upon revocation if term of registration is more than one day. Solicitors registered for one day will not receive any refund if license is revoked.

All other sections and parts of sections not changed by this ordinance shall remain in effect.


