

A RESOLUTION AMENDING ARTICLE II, SECTION 24-11,
OF THE MOUNT VERNON CITY CODE, ADOPTED
ON DECEMBER 23, 2008 ENTITLED "A RESOLUTION
DESIGNATING MUNICIPAL OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES
TO FILE AN ANNUAL FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE
STATEMENT WITH THE TEMPORARY STATE
COMMISSION ON LOCAL GOVERNMENT ETHICS."

The City of Mount Vernon, in City Council convened, does hereby ordain and enact:

Section 1. Article II, Section §24-11 of the Mount Vernon City Code, adopted December 23, 2008, is hereby amended as follows:

WHEREAS, the Ethics in Government Act, as codified in Sections 810-813 of the General Municipal Law, requires all counties, cities, towns and villages having populations of 50,000 or more to file an annual financial disclosure statement for municipal officers and employees; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mount Vernon has a population which exceeds 50,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mount Vernon is required by said law to file with the Temporary State Commission on Local Government Ethics a list of elected officials, officers and employees, of the City of Mount Vernon who are required to file said financial disclosure statement; NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the following elected officials, officers and employees of the City of Mount Vernon shall be required to file a financial disclosure statement and required by General Municipal Law Section 811, et. seq:

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In addition to the officers and employees listed in Subsection A above, all elected officials of the City of Mount Vernon and any local officer or employee who is determined by the City Council of the City of Mount Vernon to be a policymaker, influence policy decisions, or to perform any of the duties listed in General Municipal Law of this article shall be required to file a financial disclosure statement.

and be it further


RESOLVED, that said required elected officials, office and employees of the City of Mount Vernon are directed to file said financial disclosure statements as prescribed by General Municipal Law Section 811, et., seq. and in accordance with the rules and regulations as set forth in the aforementioned General Municipal Law.




