ORDINANCE 10-2020

**RENAMING “WATER WORKS WOODS” TO
“KAY SMITH’S WATER WORKS WOODS”
(PART OF BLOCK 2900, LOT 1)**

WHEREAS, Township-owned land, known as part of Block 2900, Lot 1 on the Tax Maps of the Township of Moorestown, and commonly referred to as “Water Works Woods,” which occupies the southern bank of the lowest of the three lakes that comprise Strawbridge Lake, and which extends from Kings Highway to Nixon Drive (backing up to Blazon Woods and the K-Mart Shopping Center); and

WHEREAS, Kay Smith, long-time resident, is known for her advocacy for and stewardship of Water Works Woods and Moorestown’s open spaces and environment in general; and

WHEREAS, in memory of Kay Smith and in honor of her immense contributions towards this parcel and the overall well-being of the Township’s environment, the Open Space Advisory Committee has recommended the renaming of this parcel of land to “Kay Smith’s Water Works Woods;” and

WHEREAS, the Township Council supports this recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that:

- Section 1. Township-owned land, known as part of Block 2900, Lot 1 on the Tax Maps of the Township of Moorestown, and commonly referred to as “Water Works Woods,” be renamed after Kay Smith as follows: “Kay Smith’s Water Works Woods” and any municipal records shall be updated accordingly.
- Section 2. Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.
- Section 3. Severability. In the event that any section paragraph, clause phrase, term, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment shall be rendered.
- Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after adoption.
- Section 5. Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 10-2020.
