## TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN

## **ORDINANCE NO. 18-2023**

## AMENDING CHAPTER 125 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOORESTOWN ENTITLED "PARKS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES" AND CHAPTER 168 ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest, safety, and wellbeing of the residents to amend Chapters 125 and 168 to address traffic safety concerns.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council, of the Township of Moorestown, in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that the Code of the Township of Moorestown is hereby amended as follows:

**Section 1.** "\$125-3.B. Vehicle and parking regulations" is amended by deleting the following language as follows:

"; with the exception of Jeff Young Park, on which parking shall be permitted on the grass along and within 25 feet of Lenola Road no further than the signs "no parking beyond this point."

<u>Section 2.</u> "§168-58. Schedule VIII: Stop Intersections" is hereby amended by adding the following language:

STOP SIGN ON AT INTERSECTION OF

Edgemoor Drive Highland Drive

<u>Section 3.</u> "§168-58.1 Schedule VIII: Multiway Stop Intersections" of by adding the following language:

INTERSECTION STOP SIGN ON
West Second Street and Mill Street All approaches

<u>Section 4.</u> "§168-64. Schedule XIV: Parking Prohibited at All Times" is hereby amended by adding the following language:

NAME OF STREET SIDE(S) LOCATION

Pancoast Avenue East From Main Street to Third Street

<u>Section 5.</u> "§168-76.1. Schedule XXVII: Bicycle Lanes" is hereby amended adding the following language at the end of the first paragraph:

"No person shall park a vehicle in any designated bicycle lane."

NAME OF STREET SIDE(S) LOCATION

Camden Avenue Both From Lenola Road to Maple Shade Border

**Section 6.** Regulatory signs shall be erected and maintained to effectuate the above.

**Section 7.** In all other respects, Chapters 125 and 168 shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Repealer</u>. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 9. Severability. In the event that any section paragraph, clause phrase, term, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment shall be rendered.

<u>Section 10.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance shall take effect upon proper publication in accordance with law.

**Section 11.** Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance 18-2023.
