**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT HOLLY  
AMENDING CHAPTER 265 ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” SUB-CHAPTER  
265-14.1 ENTITLED “EXCLUSION OF TRUCKS IN EXCESS OF FOUR TONS’ GROSS  
WEIGHT” AND REPEALING SUBCHAPTER 265-53.1 ENTITLED “TRUCKS IN EXCESS  
OF FOUR TONS’ GROSS WEIGHT EXCLUDED” OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP  
OF MOUNT HOLLY**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Mount Holly has the authority and jurisdiction to regulate the traffic and vehicles on the streets within the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Council of the Township of Mount Holly, upon a recommendation from Lt. Spencer, Mount Holly Police Department, has determined that it is necessary and beneficial to amend the current weight exclusions;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Township of Mount Holly, in the County of Burlington and State of New Jersey that Chapter 265 the Township Code is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION 1.**

**Chapter 265 Vehicles and Traffic**

**§ 265-14.1**

All commercial vehicles having a gross vehicle weight ratio (“GVWR”) in excess of 13 tons (26,000 lbs.), except local deliveries and school buses are hereby exclude from all streets within the Township of Mount Holly.

Local deliveries are defined as deliveries within the Township borders and includes locations where commercial vehicles are principally stored by businesses located in Mount Holly.

This section shall not apply to the following roads:

1. Route 541 – Mount Holly Bypass
2. State Highway 38
3. Woodlane Road from 541 to Eastampton Township line
4. Rancocas Road from 541 Bypass to Westampton Township line

**§265-53.1 – [RESERVED]**

**SECTION 2.** If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision of this Amendment shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance

shall be deemed valid and effective;

**SECTION 3.** If any ordinances or parts thereof are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance those provisions shall be repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance may be renumbered for codification purposes, if necessary.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication in accordance within applicable law.
