

## ORDINANCE #O-03-2023

### AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONMOUTH BEACH AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONMOUTH BEACH BY AMENDING CHAPTER 3 SECTION 3-19.3 ENTITLED “APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION; FEE; SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF REGISTRATION; DISCLAIMER”

*Chapter III Section 3-19.3 “Application for registration; fee; suspension or revocation of registration; disclaimer” of the General Ordinances of the Borough of Monmouth Beach is hereby amended or supplemented as follows (new text is double underlined, text to be deleted is ~~struck through~~ and notations to the reader and changes in subparagraph designations either with or without changes to content are italicized):*

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Borough Commissioners of the Borough of Monmouth Beach, County of Monmouth, and State of New Jersey that Chapter 3 Section 3-19.3 entitled “*Application for registration; fee; suspension or revocation of registration; disclaimer*” is hereby amended or supplemented as follows:

#### SECTION 1

3-19.3 Applications for registration; fee; suspension or revocation of registration; disclaimer.

b.        Every registration shall be issued and renewed on an annual basis, effective February 1 of each year, upon payment of an annual fee to the Borough in the amount of ~~\$50~~ \$60 for two tags. Additional tags shall be furnished at a cost of ~~\$10~~ \$15 each at the time of registration; the cost of replacements for lost or stolen tags shall be \$25 each.

#### SECTION 2

All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to such inconsistency.

#### SECTION 3

If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance is adjudged to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to section paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

#### **SECTION 4**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
