LEGISLATION

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 312-8, NO SIGNS OTHER THAN AUTHORIZED, OF CHAPTER 312, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NEW ROCHELLE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of New Rochelle:

Section 1. The Code of the City of New Rochelle, Section 312-8, No signs other than authorized, of Chapter 312, Vehicles and Traffic, is hereby amended as follows:

§ 312-8 No signs or pavement markings other than authorized.

It shall be unlawful for any person to place or maintain or to display upon or in view of any highway, <u>sidewalk</u>, or curb, any unofficial sign, signal, <u>pavement marking</u>, or device which purports to be or is an imitation of or resembles an official sign, <u>pavement marking</u>, or signal or which attempts to regulate the movement of traffic <u>or parking of vehicles</u>, or which hides from view any official sign, <u>pavement marking</u>, or signal. Any peace officer <u>and/or the Commissioner</u> <u>of Public Works</u> is hereby empowered to remove every such prohibited sign, signal, <u>pavement</u> <u>marking</u> or device without notice.
