LEGISLATION

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 281, STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC PLACES, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NEW ROCHELLE, TO ADD SECTION 281-4.1 REMOVAL OF FECES BY OWNERS AND OCCUPANTS OF LAND

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of New Rochelle:

Section 1. The Code of the City of New Rochelle, Section 281-4.1, of Chapter 281, Streets, Sidewalks and Public Places, is hereby amended as follows:

§281-4.1 Removal of feces by owners and occupants of land.

- A. It shall be the duty of the owner of any occupied or unoccupied land or premises abutting upon any public right of way to remove all dog or cat feces left thereon, including between the sidewalk and curb, whether paved or not, before 12 noon of each day, and to keep the same so cleaned and removed at all times.
 - B. The Buildings Department shall be charged with the enforcement of this Chapter.
- C. Any person found to be in violation of this chapter shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$250 for each and every day such violation exists and continues.
- D. In the event that an owner of an occupied or unoccupied land or premises shall fail to maintain the same as required by this Chapter, the Building Official may serve written abatement notice and may cause such work to be undertaken by or on behalf of the City, pursuant to the procedures set forth in Section 200 of the City Charter.
