Ordinance No. 2018-03**

“AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW PROVIDENCE,
COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER 333 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW PROVIDENCE ENTITLED
“SANITARY STANDARDS”

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the Borough of New Providence, County of Union, State of New Jersey that Chapter 333 shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 333-9, ARTICLE II, ENTITLED “PERMIT APPLICATION, INSPECTIONS, ISSUANCE” OF THE SANITARY STANDARDS CODE IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

B. Temporary Food Vendor is defined as any person(s) who transports food or food containers, who engages in food preparation or service or who comes in contact with any food, utensils or equipment and operates for a period of no longer than five (5) days in the Borough, at a location that is not considered a permanent establishment.

Temporary food vendors must apply and pay for a permit no later than fifteen (15) business days prior to the event where they are selling food and/or beverages. If the Health Inspector grants a permit after review, observance of the sanitary standards and compliance of Chapter 24 of the New Jersey State Sanitary code shall be strictly upheld and enforced. The operation shall be subject to inspection at any time.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with New Jersey law.
