

**BOARD OF HEALTH
BOROUGH OF NEW PROVIDENCE
Ordinance No. 2019-01**

“AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW PROVIDENCE,
COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER
333 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW PROVIDENCE ENTITLED “SANITARY
STANDARDS”

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the Borough of New Providence, County of Union, State of New Jersey that Chapter 333 shall be amended as follows:

Section 1. Article X, Section 62 of Chapter 333, entitled “Licenses” shall be amended to reflect the following:

No food establishment or drug dispensary shall operate without obtaining the proper license as prescribed by the Board of Health.

1. Every retail food establishment must post the most current Evaluation Placard in one of the following prominent locations clearly visible to the patron:
 - a. The main entrance door from four (4) to six (6) feet off the ground or floor;
 - b. A front window within five (5) feet of the main entrance;
 - c. A display case mounted on the outside wall within five (5) feet of the main entrance;
 - d. If there is no direct entrance to the street, final determination of the placard will be made by the Health Department and placed in a clearly visible area to the public.

Section 2. If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective immediately after publication in the manner provided by law.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately after publication in the manner provided by law.
