BOROUGH OF NEW PROVIDENCE ORDINANCE 2006-06

"AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW PROVIDENCE, COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING THE RECYCLING ORDINANCE"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough of New Providence that Chapter 213 of the Code of the Borough of New Providence is hereby amended as follows:

- Section 213-1 of Chapter 213 is hereby amended to add a new Subsection B and to renumber Subsection B, Definitions, as subsection C, as follows:
 - 213-1. Residential separation program established; definitions.
 - B. Each residence shall separate recyclable materials as set forth in subsection A above. For multi-family housing, separation of recyclable materials may be by each residential unit, or by each building or section thereof.
- 2. Section 213-11, Subsection 213-11.B., of Chapter 213 is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 213-11. Violations and Penalties.
 - B. Any person, firm or corporation who violates or neglects to comply with any provision of this chapter or regulation promulgated pursuant thereto shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00). In the case of multi-family housing where separation of recyclables is by residential unit, each unit shall

constitute a separate offense, provided that if separation of recyclables is by building or section thereof, then the maximum penalty shall be five hundred (\$500.00) times the number of housing units for which the recyclables are being collected.

3. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
