**BOROUGH OF NEW PROVIDENCE
ORDINANCE 2006-06**

**"AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW PROVIDENCE, COUNTY OF UNION,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING THE RECYCLING ORDINANCE"**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough of New Providence that Chapter 213 of the Code of the Borough of New Providence is hereby amended as follows:

1. Section 213-1 of Chapter 213 is hereby amended to add a new Subsection B and to renumber Subsection B, Definitions, as subsection C, as follows:

213-1. Residential separation program established; definitions.

- B. Each residence shall separate recyclable materials as set forth in subsection A above. For multi-family housing, separation of recyclable materials may be by each residential unit, or by each building or section thereof.

2. Section 213-11, Subsection 213-11.B., of Chapter 213 is hereby amended to read as follows:

213-11. Violations and Penalties.

- B. Any person, firm or corporation who violates or neglects to comply with any provision of this chapter or regulation promulgated pursuant thereto shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00). In the case of multi-family housing where separation of recyclables is by residential unit, each unit shall

constitute a separate offense, provided that if separation of recyclables is by building or section thereof, then the maximum penalty shall be five hundred (\$500.00) times the number of housing units for which the recyclables are being collected.

3. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
