

BOROUGH OF NEW PROVIDENCE
ORDINANCE 2012-06

**“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 213 OF THE
CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW PROVIDENCE ENTITLED “RECYCLING”**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Providence,
in the County of Union and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Article I of Chapter 213, entitled “Definitions” shall be amended to
include the following:

Designated recyclable materials- means those materials designated below that
shall be source separated for the purpose of recycling. These materials
include:

A. Designated Materials for Residential Waste Generators:

- Aluminum, tin, steel
- Bulky rigid plastic items
- Corrugated cardboard;
- Glass Containers
- Grass, Brush, Leaves
- Household Batteries (Button Cell, Rechargeable)
- Leaves
- Mixed Paper
- Motor Oil
- Motor Oil Filters
- Newspaper
- Office Paper
- Plastic Containers (#1 & #2)
- Tires
- Vehicle Batteries
- White Goods (air conditioners, refrigerators)
- Wood

Bulky rigid plastic items – shall include, but not be limited to, plastic tables,
benches, chairs, riding toys, doll houses, sand boxes, shelving, 5 gallon pails,
car seats, and Tyco products.

Section 2. Article III of Chapter 213, entitled “Collection of Recyclable
Materials” shall be amended to include the following:

- C. All bulky rigid plastic items shall be brought to the public works yard Monday
thru Friday 7am to 2 pm.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage and publication in the manner as provided by law.
